






OUR LOCATION



Regional Group Australia was on the ground delivering mobile concrete supply at one of Queensland's largest renewable energy developments, Wambo Wind Farm. We supplied concrete for 83 turbine foundations using two on-site batching plants with a combined output of 130m³ per hour and a fleet of 20 twin-steer agitator trucks.

This operation kept concrete flowing to some of the largest turbine bases in Australia and played a key role in driving the state's renewable energy future.
